

Congregation Beit Tikvah COVID-19 Rules for In-Person Services

- Masks will be worn at all times inside the building.
- Reservations are required by Thursday at noon before the service in order to attend the service, please email: info@beittikvah.org. Your reservation allows for the proper number of chairs made available for you and your family. It also allows for you to receive a Kiddush Bag filled with prepackaged food items.
- Chairs will be arranged 6 feet apart except for families or pod groups.
- Members and guests must sign in on an attendance sheet, provide an email address, and answer a few questions.
- We take the temperature of every member and guest before entering the building. Everyone with a fever will be asked to go home. Anyone exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms will be asked to go home.
- Only the Rabbi or service leader will touch the Torah. Ritual objects will be cleaned after each use.
- If you do not feel well or may be sick, or if you've been exposed to COVID-19 in the past two weeks, please stay home.
- If you develop COVID-19 after visiting Congregation Beit Tikvah, please notify us by email to: info@beittikvah.org.
- Hand shaking and hugging is discouraged among those who are not in your family or pod.
- All chairs, books, etc. will be cleaned before returning to storage. (volunteers are greatly appreciated)
- We will do our part to keep all members and guests safe. We thank you for your efforts to protect your safety and those of other members and guests. At the same time, we cannot guarantee that you will not be exposed to COVID-19 at Congregation Beit Tikvah. And, we are not liable if you contract COVID-19 at Congregation Beit Tikvah.
- These Rules will be revisited as Maryland and Baltimore City change their Protocols.
