COVID-19 Safety Procedures for In-Person Services

- Masks will be worn at all times inside the building.
- Reservations are required by the designated deadline before the service in order to attend the service. Please email: info@beittikvah.org. Your reservation allows for the proper number of chairs to be made available for you and your family. It also allows for you to receive prepackaged or individual portions of food items.
- Chairs will be arranged 6 feet apart except for families or pod groups.
- Members and guests must sign in on an attendance sheet, provide an email address, and answer a few questions.
- If you do not feel well or may be sick, or if you've been exposed to COVID-19 in the past two weeks, please stay home.
- If you develop COVID-19 after visiting Congregation Beit Tikvah, please notify us by email to: info@beittikvah.org.
- Hand shaking and hugging is discouraged among those who are not in your family or pod.
- Only the Rabbi or service leader will touch the Torah. Ritual objects will be cleaned after each use.
- All chairs, books, etc. will be cleaned before returning to storage. (volunteers are greatly appreciated)
- We will do our part to keep all members and guests safe. We thank you for your efforts to protect your safety and those of other members and guests. At the same time, we cannot guarantee that you will not be exposed to COVID-19 at Congregation Beit Tikvah. And, we are not liable if you contract COVID-19 at Congregation Beit Tikvah.
- These Rules will be revisited as Maryland and Baltimore City change their Protocols.
